AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 16 2015, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows: 17 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby 18 19 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license 20 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other 21 22 subject as provided by this section. 23 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 24 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of

ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 11 12 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 13 applications for special license plates authorized under this 14 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 15 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 16 17 information directly into such system and generate a receipt accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 18 19 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 20 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 21 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 22

If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,

1 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 2 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 3 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 4 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 5 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 6 removed from the vehicle.

Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special 7 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special 8 9 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission 10 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications 11 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax 12 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective 13 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null 14 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are 15 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly. 16

The special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 10 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 11 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 12 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 13 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 14 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 15 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 16 17 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations and 2 shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Energy 3 Resources Board from assessments received and collected pursuant to 4 5 Section 288.8A of this title, donations, grants, contributions and gifts from any public or private source and monies deposited 6 pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the 7 Oklahoma Statutes. The Board may expend funds as provided for by 8 9 law. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued 10 by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law 11 with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 12 Services for approval and payment.

B. Of the monies collected and not refunded pursuant to 13 Sections 288.8A and 288.9A of this title, a minimum of fifty percent 14 (50%) of said monies collected, including a prorated share of 15 administrative costs incurred from the effective date of this act, 16 17 and not subsequently refunded, shall be expended on environmental cleanup and remediation projects related to oil and gas pollution 18 19 authorized by the Board from a priority list of projects submitted 20 by the Corporation Commission or, only in the absence of Corporation 21 Commission jurisdiction, projects submitted by other appropriate 22 state agencies.
