49. Why are you seeking this position?

**It would be the honor of a lifetime to represent my hometown district as a member of the Supreme Court. I have committed myself to public service, and my years as Oklahoma Solicitor General have offered me the opportunity to routinely litigate cases before the Supreme Court, such that I am uniquely familiar with the Court's jurisprudence and practices. My temperament is well suited to the bench, and I am a student of judicial and legal philosophy, with a well-developed understanding of the proper role of the judiciary in our State's form of government. That understanding comes, in part, from my Executive Branch experience and my experience as a practitioner before the Court, both of which are currently lacking on the Court. Lastly, because I am the most frequent practitioner before the Court, I have litigated dozens of significant constitutional law cases involving most every frequently litigated provision in our state constitution. This experience will allow me to come to the Court well positioned to tackle the difficult constitutional questions the Court must confront.**

**Line 1b.** Enter your employer identification number (EIN) if your request relates to a business return. Otherwise, enter the first social security number (SSN) or your individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN) shown on the return. For example, if you are requesting Form 1040 that includes Schedule C (Form 1040), enter your SSN.

**Corporations.** Generally, Form 4506-T can be signed by: (1) an officer having legal authority to bind the corporation, (2) any person designated by the board of directors or other governing body, or (3) any officer or employee on written request by any principal officer and attested to by the secretary or other officer. A bona fide shareholder of record owning 1 percent or more of the outstanding stock of the corporation may submit a Form 4506-T but must provide documentation to support the requester's right to receive the information.

**Partnerships.** Generally, Form 4506-T can be signed by any person who was a member of the partnership during any part of the tax period requested on line 9.

**All others.** See section 6103(e) if the taxpayer has died, is insolvent, is a dissolved corporation, or if a trustee, guardian, executor, receiver, or administrator is acting for the taxpayer.

**Note:** If you are Heir at law, Next of kin, or Beneficiary you must be able to establish a material interest in the estate or trust.

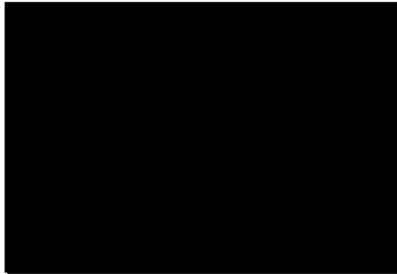
