19	A. No abortion shall be performed in this state without the
20	written informed consent of the father of the baby.
21	B. A pregnant woman seeking to abort her pregnancy shall be
22	required, at her expense, to provide in writing the identity of the
23	father of the baby to the physician who is to perform or induce the
24	abortion. If the person identified as the father of the baby

1 challenges the fact that he is the father, such individual, at his 2 expense, may demand that a paternity test be performed. 3 C. This section shall not apply if the father of the baby is 4 deceased and the woman upon whom the abortion is to be performed or 5 induced signs a notarized affidavit attesting to that fact. 6 This section shall not apply in cases in which a woman upon D. 7 whom the abortion is to be performed or induced was the victim of 8 rape or incest, and the pregnancy resulted from the rape or incest, 9 or in cases where the physician determines that the carrying of the 10 baby places the woman's life in danger. 11 SECTION 2.
