**ORDER DENYING OKLAHOMA ATTORNEY GENERAL’S RENEWED MOTION TO

The Corporation Commission (“Commission”) of the State of Oklahoma being regularly in session and the undersigned Commissioners present and participating, there comes on for consideration and action the Oklahoma Attorney General’s Renewed Motion to Dismiss (“Motion”) filed on December 14, 2017, and heard by the Commission *en banc* on December 21, 2017.

After reviewing the record and hearing the arguments of the parties, the Commission finds that the Motion should be denied.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

THE COMMISSION FURTHER FINDS that the Oklahoma Attorney General’s Renewed Motion to Dismiss should be denied.


ORDER
