AMENDING CHAPTER 59, OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL  
CODE, 2010; ARTICLE VII, SECTION 7250.2 CONCERNING THE  
HISTORIC DISTRICT DESIGNATION PROCESS**

**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY:**

**Chapter 59**

**ZONING AND PLANNING CODE**

**SECTION 1.** That Chapter 59, Article VII, Section 7250.2 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code 2010, is hereby amended to read as follows:

*7250.2 Historic District Designation.*

A. *Historic District Designation Process.*

\*\*\*

(3) Except as provided herein, the initiation of a proposal for designation may shall  
only be made by the Historic Preservation Commission, City Council, or Planning  
Commission, or by the application of more than 50 percent of the owners of the  
parcel to be designated, or their authorized agents, which may include neighborhood  
associations. Provided, if more than 50% of the owners of a parcel to be designated  
support the designation, the Historic Preservation Commission or Planning  
Commission may initiate a proposal for designation. Any application shall be made  
upon forms or pursuant to standards set by the Historic Preservation Commission for  
this purpose. Within 90 days of the initiation of a proposal for designation, the



Historic Preservation Commission shall consider and provide a recommendation on the proposal.

(7) ~~The Historic Preservation Commission~~ ~~City Council~~ shall have the authority to ~~initiate~~ ~~effect~~ the amendment or repeal of any designation of a site, structure, building, district or monument ~~as a historic district, but only if more than 50% of the owners of the site, structure, building, district or monument to be impacted support such amendment or repeal. Upon initiation of such an amendment or repeal by the Historic Preservation Commission, it shall be processed~~ in the same manner, and according to the same procedure, as provided herein for the original designation.
