AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT

THE UNDERSIGNED PERSON, BEING DULY SWORN UPON HER OATH, DEPOSES AND STATES AS FOLLOWS:

This search warrant affidavit applies to the following records and evidence limited to the time frame of November 1, 2018 through January 31, 2019:

- (1.) All stored communications and other files reflecting communications to or from halltripp6@gmail.com;
- (2.) All files that have been accessed by halltripp6@gmail.com or are controlled by user accounts associated with halltripp6@gmail.com;
- (3.) All logs and records of user activity for halltripp6@gmail.com, including;
 - 1. Contents of Google+ Photos, to include all albums, photos, videos, and metadata for each file;
 - 2. Content of all Google+ posts and/or comments associated with the account, as well as a copy of the Google+ profile and Google+ Circles and contacts;
 - 3. All files/folders present in the user's Google Drive;
 - 4. YouTube subscriber information, copies of videos and associated metadata, and any YouTube comments or private messages;
 - 5. Copies of email content as per usual;
 - 6. Copies of any blogs, comments, or posts to blogs;
 - 7. For the target account(s), provide the Android/iPhone device information, including IMEI/MEID, make and model, serial number, date and IP of last access to Google, and a list of all accounts that have ever been active on the device.
- (4.) All subscriber information provided to Google, to include, but not limited to, name, address, gender, age, and occupation, for the email address halltripp6@gmail.com

FURTHER, YOUR AFFIANT STATES, IN SUPPORT OF THIS APPLICATION AND FOR SHOWING THAT THERE IS PROBABLE CAUSE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A SEARCH WARRANT, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT, your affiant is ELIZABETH GREEN, a certified and commissioned peace officer in and for the State of Oklahoma and is currently employed as a Lieutenant for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI). Your affiant has been in Law Enforcement for approximately 18.5 years. Your affiant's training and education has included a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice from Oklahoma City University; Advanced Peace Officer certification with the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET); the OSBI Agents Academy; and more than 2,500 hours of CLEET-approved continuing education. Your affiant has personal knowledge of this investigation or has received information from other law enforcement officers.

THAT, on March 28, 2019, ELIZABETH WOOLLEN, Chief, University of Oklahoma Police Department, requested OSBI investigative assistance into some allegations against DAVID BOREN and TRIPP HALL. It was alleged that BOREN and HALL inappropriately kissed and touched former and current students and employees of the University of Oklahoma.

THAT, a student at the University of Oklahoma, herein referred to as AW321998, was interviewed by OSBI Agent MEGHAN BOWMAN. AW321998 stated he met HALL at the University of Oklahoma at a book club. After the book club, HALL invited AW321998 out for tea and befriended him.

THAT, over the winter break, AW321998 and HALL communicated with each other. HALL said he visited a vacation spot, maybe Cancun, and offered AW321998 and HALL go there sometime.

THAT, in January 2019, AW321998 met up with HALL at HALL'S house, 627 Classen Boulevard, Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma. AW321998 tried to tell HALL about a medical incident he incurred over winter break, and HALL offered AW321998 a massage. HALL said "don't worry, you don't have to say anymore." HALL said he would stop when it went too far, and for AW321998 to say "stop" or "no" then he would stop the massage.

THAT, AW321998 felt like he could not tell HALL "no", even though HALL said to tell him when to stop. AW321998 felt like he was on some sort of substance because he could process everything that was going on around him, but did not feel like he could respond at all, like an out of body experience.

THAT, HALL performed oral sex on AW321998. Afterwards, AW321998 sent HALL three text messages stating their friendship was over, and AW321998 did not want to do anything with HALL again. AW321998 blocked all electronic communication with HALL.

THAT, AW321998 and HALL communicated through text messages, instant messages, and emails from November 2018 through January 2019. HALL and AW321998 made plans through these above described communications to meet up.

THAT, AW321998 gave BOWMAN consent to dump his cell phones he used to communicate with HALL. AW321998'S cell phones were processed at the OSBI Digital Evidence Unit (DEU) Laboratory. The OSBI DEU Laboratory provided BOWMAN with exhibit reports of the information extracted from AW321998'S cell phones. BOWMAN reviewed the exhibit reports from AW321998'S cell phones and found the following:

THAT, HALL communicated to AW321998 using cell phone number 405/301-1039 and email address halltripp6@gmail.com. The phone number and email address were stored under contact name "Tripp Hall".

THAT, communication between HALL and AW321998 started on November 17, 2018. HALL sent AW321998 an email using halltripp6@gmail.com. The content of the email was not captured.

THAT, the undersigned affiant submits based on the facts set forth in this affidavit, that there is probable cause to believe that the Google Gmail Account was used for Rape, Oklahoma Statute Title 21, Chapter 45, Section 1114. *contains relevant information pertaining to the investigation of EG 8/12/2019*

THAT, a search of the Oklahoma Secretary of State's website found a listing for Google, LLC. under Corporation Service Company, 10300 Greenbriar Place, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73159. Said address is located in Oklahoma County, allowing this Court to have jurisdiction.


THAT, the statements in this Affidavit include information provided by witness testimony. Since this affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of securing a search warrant, the Affiant has not included each and every fact known concerning this investigation. The Affiant has set forth only the facts that are believed necessary to establish probable cause to support the issuance of a search warrant.

THAT, Based upon the above-described facts, Your Affiant respectfully requests that a search warrant be issued to Google, LLC. located at 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, for the Google Gmail account halltripp6@gmail.com, and the items listed above in sections 1 through 4.



Now comes the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, a governmental entity, by and through Lieutenant ELIZABETH GREEN, who, being duly sworn and upon her oath, does state as follows as the Applicant for this Order.


Lieutenant ELIZABETH GREEN, on behalf of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, respectfully applies to this court for an order prohibiting Google, LLC. to disclose, to the customer or subscriber identified above, the issuance of a request for records or information pursuant to 18 U.S.C. 2703.

In support of this application, your applicant respectfully submits to this court as follows:


1. This court is a court of competent jurisdiction to issue such orders as defined by Title 18 Section 2711 and Section 3127 of the United States Code, and Title 13 Section 177.1 *et seq.* of the Oklahoma Statutes.
2. As a court of competent jurisdiction, this Court has the authority to order the prohibition of disclosure of the above information, pursuant to Title 18 of the United States Code, Section 2703 (c) and (d), based upon the specific and articulable facts, set forth below.
3. Your Applicant is currently conducting a criminal investigation related to the offense of Rape, Oklahoma Statute Title 21, Chapter 45 Section 1114.
4. Your applicant has reason to believe that notifying the subscriber of the existing order relating to the Google Gmail account halltripp6@gmail.com, will result in the destruction of or tampering with evidence.
5. Your Applicant requests this court issue an order precluding Google, LLC. from notifying the subscriber identified above of the existence of this order or any resulting order, as 18 U.S.C. 2703(c)(3) specifically provides that the governmental entity need not notify the subscriber or customer of the existence of an order with the reason stated above.

As a result of the reasons set forth above, your Applicant further requests this Court, pursuant to Title 18 Section 2703(c)(3), seal this Application and any resultant Order to carry out the provisions of Section 2703(c)(3).

ORDER PRECLUDING SUBSCRIBER
NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO 18 U.S.C. 2705(b)


This Court, having considered the Application of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, through Lieutenant ELIZABETH GREEN, for an order requiring the disclosure of certain customer or subscriber information by Google, LLC. finds as follows:

1. This Court is a Court of competent jurisdiction as defined by 18 U.S.C. 2711(3) and 18 U.S.C. 3127, and because this Court is authorized by Title 13 Section 177.1 *et seq.* of the Oklahoma Statutes to enter orders regarding electronic communication.
2. The information or records sought by the Applicant is of the type specifically provided for in 18 U.S.C. 2703(C).
3. The Applicant and the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation are a governmental entity as that term is used in 18 U.S.C. 2703(c), and have set forth specific and articulable facts showing that they have an ongoing criminal investigation and that the records or information they seek are relevant to this criminal investigation, thus meeting the requirements of 18 U.S.C. 2703(C).
4. That a lawful Order Requiring the Disclosure of Certain Records or Information has been issued to Google, LLC.
5. That the order requesting these records pertains to Google Gmail account **halltripp6@gmail.com**.
6. That notification to the subscriber of the issuance of this order will likely will result in the destruction of or tampering with evidence.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Google, LLC. not disclose to the customer or subscriber the existence of this Order or the Application for this Order, as provided for by 18 U.S.C. 2703(c)(3) for 120 days following the date on which the order is signed.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order and the associated Application be sealed by the Clerk of the District Court, and shall be unsealed only upon Order of this Court of a competent jurisdiction.
