OBJECTION OF THE RESPONDENTS TO PETITIONER'S
MOTION FOR EMERGENCY ORDER TO STAY ALL PROCEEDINGS and
OBJECTION TO PETITIONER'S MOTION TO STAY

COMES NOW the Respondents above named, by and through the Honorable Lori M. Walkley, acting Chief Judge of the Cleveland County District Court in the absence of the Honorable Thad Balkman, and request this Honorable Court to deny the Petitioner's request for an Emergency Order to stay the Show Cause Hearing currently set for July 21, 2020 at 3:30 p.m. and July 22, 2020, at 4:00 p.m. in Cleveland County. In addition, Respondents request that this Honorable Court deny Petitioner's separately filed Motion to Stay All Proceedings. In support of their Response, the Respondents allege and state as follows:

Respondents are aware that Petitioner has filed a Writ of Prohibition challenging the Administrative Orders of both Canadian and Cleveland County as they relate to the transport of detainees to the Oklahoma County Jail when arrested in and/or for crimes committed and triable in Canadian and Cleveland Counties.
