COUNT 1: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ 21 O.S. § 1451, a FELONY
COUNT 2: COMPUTER FRAUD / UNLAWFUL USE OF COMPUTER / SYSTEM ~ 21 O.S. § 1953, a FELONY

STATE OF OKLAHOMA, COUNTY OF PONTOTOC:

I, Paul B. Smith, the undersigned District Attorney of said County, in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, give information that in said County of Pontotoc and in the State of Oklahoma, BRIAN DAVID HAMPTON did then and there unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully commit the crime(s) of:

COUNT 1: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or between the 1st day of August, 2019 and the 20th day of November, 2019, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$98,765.07 that belonged to East Central University and had been entrusted to the said defendant by East Central University.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for up to 8 years and a fine not to exceed \$10,000 and restitution.

COUNT 2: COMPUTER FRAUD / UNLAWFUL USE OF COMPUTER / SYSTEM ~ a FELONY, on or between the 1st day of August, 2019 and the 20th day of November, 2019, by using his employer's computer system to alter financial transactions.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 10 years and/or a fine of not less than \$5,000 but not exceeding \$100,000.

PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

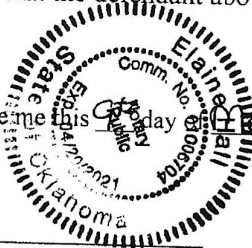
The undersigned, upon oath, deposes and states as follows, to wit: I, **Bert H Miller**, Police Officer for the East Central University Police Department, hereinafter called affiant, has reason to believe and does believe, that between August 01, 2019 and November 13, 2019, at East Central University, in the city of Ada, in Pontotoc County Oklahoma. Brian Hampton, hereinafter called defendant, did then and there commit the crimes of: **Embezzlement 21§ 1451, Violation Computer Crimes Act 21§ 1953.**

Affiant's belief is based on information obtained and subsequent investigation conducted by affiant.

On November 20, 2019 at or around 1515hrs, defendant came to East Central University (ECU) to bring back, One Hundred Fifty Thousand 150,000 dollars in checks and cash belonging to ECU that he had taken home, and discuss what had been going on. Voluntary upon his own free will, defendant disclosed as Bursar for ECU to taking several thousands of dollars in deposits/game money cash and converting it for a personal use starting around August 2019. Defendant used his access with the University's computer system (Jenzabar) to use system and alter financial transactions of the University. Financial Audit conducted by outside group addressing allegations confirmed what the defendant had admitted and came to an amount of Ninety Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Five Dollars Seven Cents 98765.07 still missing beyond what defendant had brought back.

Based on this information, the undersigned prays that this honorable court issue a finding of fact that probable cause exists to believe that a crime has been committed and there is probable cause to believe that the defendant above named committed that crime.
