Count 1:

On or about October 26, 2022, in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, RYAN LEE MARTINEZ, did commit the crime of Actual Physical Control Of Vehicle While Intoxicated, a Felony, by unlawfully, willfully and wrongfully be in actual physical control of a certain motor vehicle, towit: 2018 Toyota, at a location of 9 E. I, Maria Serafin, being duly sworn Police Officer for the City of Edmond do swear the following statements to be true:

On 10/26/2022 at approximately 2341 hours, I was dispatched to a possible Drunk Driver in the parking lot of the Patriarch located at 9 E Edwards Street, Edmond, OK, Oklahoma County.

Dispatch advised the business refused to serve the Defendant after he arrived intoxicated. They also advised the Defendant was last seen stumbling while getting into a white SUV. When I arrived on scene, I observed the vehicle (OK TAG H39) was running and the Defendant was sitting inside the driver's seat.

I observed The Defendant had difficulty stepping out of the vehicle. I asked the Defendant how much he had to drink tonight, and he stated, "A couple beers in the Patriarch". I then asked the Defendant what his plan was right now, and he stated, "I was going to head to my house right across". The Defendant stated he started drinking around 2200 hours and he believed the current time was 1 in the morning. The actual time was approximately 2347 hours. He then stated he had about 3 to 4 drinks and now believed it was around 0130 to 0200 hours.

As I continued questioning the Defendant, I observed his speech was slurred and he was unsteady on his feet. The Defendant then stated he had two single Vodka-Tonics in the Patriarch, and they were approximately 8 oz each.

I asked the Defendant if he would be willing to take Standardized Field Sobriety tests and he agreed to take the tests. During the tests I observed multiple clues of intoxication.

Based on my observations of the Defendant, I then placed the Defendant under arrest at approximately 0023 hours (10/27/2022). The car keys were located in the ignition of the vehicle. Sergeant Shortt, drove the vehicle forward and backwards to ensure it was operable. I read the Defendant Implied Consent Test request (dated 11/1/2019) and offered him a breath test at 0042 hours. The Defendant refused to take the States Test by stating "I do not submit". I hand delivered a copy of the IDAP and Officer's Affidavit to the Defendant.

Based on these facts and circumstances that occurred in the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma County, I believe Probable Cause exists for the filing of criminal charges for: Actual Physical Control of A Motor Vehicle Under the Influence of Alcohol (47-11.902.A.2).
