I, Lt. Mark Oak, being a duly sworn Police Officer for the City of Edmond do swear the following statements to be true:

On 3/29/2023, Your Affiant was informed of an anonymous letter that was recently sent to the Chief's Office of the Edmond Police Department. The information contained in the letter included information related to a former officer still working within the police department, having an inappropriate relationship with a 14-year-old female last summer (2022). The information also stated, "He was texting her at school, during night, sometimes 60 or 70 texts a day." Information in the letter stated some of the text messages included "are you a virgin?" and "I want to be your first."

During the investigation, the only current employee at the Edmond Police Department that matched the information in the letter was identified as the Defendant (currently a civil employee with the City of Edmond). The Defendant at the time of this incident was living in his RV at the [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] in Oklahoma City, OK. which is located within Oklahoma County. The 14-year-old female mentioned in the letter was identified and forensically interviewed on 4/7/2023. During the forensic interview, the minor child confirmed the Defendant was her [REDACTED]. The minor child said she would spend time with the Defendant at his work and run errands with him. They also spent time around other family members and the Defendant's wife.


During the forensic interview, the minor child disclosed that the Defendant would text message her and video chatted via the application "Google Duo." The minor child confirmed the Defendant did send her text messages asking her if she had ever had sex and telling her he wanted to be her first. The minor child also talked about how the Defendant would tell her how "hot" and "sexy" she looked. The minor child said the Defendant would make her feel uncomfortable with these types of comments and she would tell the Defendant she was going to tell his wife. The minor child said the Defendant responded by telling her not to do that because

his wife would leave him. The minor child also talked about a time that she was talking with the Defendant, and he wanted her to sneak out of the house one night so he could come pick her up. The minor child also said that the Defendant told her during their relationship to delete the text messages between them.

Based on these facts and circumstances that occurred in the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma County, I believe Probable Cause exists for the filing of criminal charge: ONE COUNT OF Facilitating, Encouraging, Offering or Soliciting Sexual Conduct or Engaging in Sexual Communication with a Minor or Person Believed to be a Minor. (OS 21-1040.13a)
