NARRATIVE No: 1 - Officer: MASHORE, JEREMY

On Wednesday, September 28, 2022, at approximately 0230 HRS, In the State of Oklahoma, County of Oklahoma, Town of Valley Brook, I, Officer Jeremy Mashore, a CLEET certified peace officer in and for the State of Oklahoma, commissioned and employed by the Valley Brook Police Department, was at the Valley Brook Police Department, within Valley Brook, Oklahoma 73149, and within the corporate town limits for the Town of Valley Brook, Oklahoma. During that time, I received a call from RONALD CURIS HAYES JR. DOB [REDACTED] the manager of the Deja Vu entertainment Establishment, located at 1540 Southeast 59th street, Valley Brook, Oklahoma, 73149. Following, during the call, Mr. Hayes indicated a fight had recently occurred within the building, and the alleged victim was requesting law enforcement intervention.

Therefore, I immediately traveled to the Deja Vu Entertainment Establishment, whereas upon arrival, I observed Mr. Hayes standing near the front doors of the building with a male subject, later identified as DUSTIN BRADLEY HAND [REDACTED]. I exited my patrol car, approached both parties, and observed Mr. Hand had a great amount of a red stain consistent with blood amongst his clothing. In addition, I noted Mr. Hand had a towel, he was wiping the red stains from his face, to which I noted and observed the strong odor consistent and commonly associated with an alcoholic beverage emitted from his breath and or person when he spoke. Upon inquiry, Mr. Hand stated he did not desire nor did he want an ambulance to respond to the incident.

Further, Mr. Hayes indicated the incident had began inside of the club. During that time, Mr. Hayes stated Mr. Hand had been inside the club, seated, and was watching dances from various entertainers. Thereafter, Mr. Hand overheard an argument occurring near the area where he was seated, he had stood up, walked over, and attempted to intervene, in that, trying to stop the incident from escalating further. However, unbeknownst to Mr. Hand, the individuals were friends, and were not attempting to engage in a fight at all. Mr. Hand allegedly returned to his seat, whereas he observed an additional argument occur, Mr. Hand allegedly stood up, walked over, and again attempted to keep the parties from fighting. At this time, a larger group of individuals were walking to the area, all of who were not at work but were and are employees of the building.

Between the parties, Mr. Hand made a statement to the effect of the individuals needed to stop or they would be thrown out of the club. This sparked an argument between Mr. Hand and another individual to who then asked allegedly, "What are you going to do about it". Mr. Hand then pushed the subject, whereas a fight broke out, Mr. Hand was struck multiple times, yet the fight ended shortly after. Mr. Hayes indicated the parties were still inside and they were employees of his, offered to go and get them, and did bring one individual outside, to who stated he was the one involved in the fight.

During that time, I met with MICHAEL WAYNE BUTTS [REDACTED] to who stated he was more then willingly to speak with me and advise of what had occurred. Mr. Butts indicated the incident was a misunderstanding, Mr. Hand had taken it the wrong way, and had pushed him, therefore, in self-defense, he then threw a punch striking Mr. Hand in the face. Mr. Butts was adamant he did not start the altercation, and indicated he had only threw a punch because Mr. Hand laid hands on him first. I requested Mr. Hayes to show me video camera footage of the incident, he agreed, and indicated Mr. Hand had advised him he was a law enforcement officer.

Upon review of the video, it was highly difficult to see or determine anything based on the angle, view, and area. Further, multiple attempts were made to view the incident, however, there is no definitive video showing who was at fault. Therefore, as Mr. Hand stated he was a law enforcement officer, I had the impression he was tell me the truth regarding the incident. I asked Mr. Hand to step back outside with me, yet notably, while attempting to watch the security footage, Mr. Hand had the impression people were talking about him, that is, individuals he had recently been in a fight with, were yelling at one another, thus I, along with Deja Vu management exited the management office, the argument ceased, and we returned to the management room, yet no no avail, a full video of the incident could not be determined.

Therefore, we exited the management room, I met with Mr. Hand in the hallway, and requested he come outside to finish speaking with me regrading the events to the incident. Once outside the front doors of the building, I inquired from Mr. Hand what had occurred inside prior to my arrival. During this time, Mr. Hand was not under arrest, not detained, and he was free to leave at anytime, this investigation was per his request. However, upon inquiry, Mr. Hand began conversing the events, yet it seemed he was leaving some portions out. Thus, I inquired from Mr. Hand how he ended up being hit in the first place, and if he had ever touched Mr. Butts, or otherwise, the other parties within the altercation. Mr. Hand indicated when the argument began, when someone within the group, believing to be Mr. Butts asked what he was going to do about it, Mr. Hand pushed Mr. Butts. Therefore, Mr. Hand made first physical contact with the other parties in the club, to which the fight then began.

In closing, Mr. Hand and I discussed the law of battery, whereas Mr. Butts later emerged from inside of the club and indicated he did not want to file any charges. In addition, Mr. Hand indicated he had been drinking earlier in the evening, and upon inquiry, on a scale of one to ten, one being stone cold sober ready to go to church, and ten being drunk and passed out in a ditch, Mr. Hand stated he was at approximately a "three". Therefore, I advised Mr. Hand no charges would be filed against him at that time, and asked him to get a ride to take him home, one for safety, and two so he would not be drinking and driving. Mr. Hand agreed, I departed the area, and drove to the Valley Brook Police Department. No charges were filed within this incident. For additional information on this case see attached copies.
