SYNOPSIS OF ARREST TO INCLUDE ALL ELEMENTS OF THE CHARGED CRIME:

I, TROOPER PRESTON COX #248, was on duty in Logan County on May 11th, 2022. At about 0029 hours I was Northbound on Interstate 35 and Seward Road and saw the driver of a black colored car (OK Tag # [REDACTED]) also Northbound on Interstate 35. The driver of the car had the cars' high beam lights on and was within one (1) car length of another motorist. I activated my emergency equipment and conducted a traffic stop on Interstate 35 Northbound and Seward Road. I made contact with the driver of the car and identified her as NANCY ELIZABETH KEMP. I asked KEMP to exit the car and she did. I asked KEMP to sit in the front seat of my patrol unit to continue speaking with me, and she agreed.
While speaking to KEMP, I smelled the odor of an alcoholic beverage on her person. I asked KEMP where she was coming from and she told me she was on her way from the Speak Easy Bar located in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. I asked KEMP if she drank any alcohol this evening and she told me she did. KEMP said she drank one (1) mixed drink and identified the drink as "Tequila". KEMP said she drank "Alot" of water before leaving. While continuing to speak with KEMP, I noticed her to have red watery blood shot eyes and slurred speech. After conducting a check on OLETS, I put my patrol unit into reverse to create a gap between KEMP'S car and my patrol unit to conduct a Standardized Field Sobriety Test.
After placing my patrol unit in reverse I told KEMP I had completed the license check and needed to make sure she was safe to operate a motor vehicle before leaving. KEMP aggressively opened my door and slammed her left hand on my computer in attempt to take her license before fleeing from my patrol unit. I placed my patrol unit in park and immediately

covered my service weapon to prevent her from trying to take it. I grabbed the back of KEMPS neck with my right hand in attempt to prevent her from fleeing. KEMP continued to pull and thrust her body weight in attempt to flee the scene. I removed KEMP from my patrol unit by rolling out of the passenger side door before landing on the ground. I had a successful back mount on KEMP and attempted to place her left hand behind her back. I ordered KEMP multiple times to place her hands behind her back and she refused. KEMP continued to resist me by trying to keep her hands under her body.

In order to gain compliance, I struck KEMP in the face two times with my right knee. I continued to order KEMP to give her hands and KEMP continued to actively resist by not placing her hands behind her back. I struck KEMP in the face with my right elbow one (1) time. I was able to gain compliance and place handcuffs on KEMP. While attempting to radio into to OHP Troop A Dispatch, KEMP slipped her handcuffs and was able to remove them from one of her wrists. I told KEMP she was under arrest at approximately 0058 hours.

I gained control of KEMP and placed her into a back mount for a second time. KEMP continued to resist me and attempted to grab something under her. I successfully prevented KEMP from grabbing the object by striking her an additional two (2) times with my right knee in the face. I gained compliance and successfully placed the handcuffs on KEMP'S wrists for a second time. I contacted OHP Troop A Dispatch and requested additional units to come to my location as backup. I also requested an ambulance for KEMP due to her having blood on her face. Logan County Deputy ROBERTS #210 arrived on scene first and placed KEMP into the back of his patrol unit.

GUTHRIE EMS arrived on scene and conducted a check of KEMP on scene. ROBERTS then transported KEMP to Mercy - Logan County Hospital where she was checked for her injuries. While at the hospital, I read KEMP the State's Implied Consent Blood Test Request at approximately 0135 hours. KEMP agreed to take the State's Blood Test by saying, "Yes". The State's Blood Test was conducted at approximately 0205 hours from KEMP'S right arm by NURSE HOISINGTON, RN at approximately 0205 hours. I secured the State's Blood Test as evidence and secured it in the trunk of my patrol unit. I later submitted the State's Blood Test to OSBI - Edmond for further analysis.

KEMP was cleared fit to be incarcerated and was transported to the Logan County Jail where she was booked for the listed charges. While at the Logan County Jail, I provided KEMP a copy of the Blood Test Officer's Affidavit and IDAP Forms and placed them into her personal property at the Logan County Jail.
