Vicki Zemp Behenna, the District Attorney of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, informs the District Court, that:

Count 1: On or about August 3, 2023, in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, JENNIFER HADDOCK, did commit the crime of First Degree Manslaughter, a Felony, while in a heat of passion did cause the death of SEAN HADDOCK by means of a dangerous weapon, the death of which was not excusable or justifiable, by JENNIFER HADDOCK shooting SEAN HADDOCK during a dispute, thereby inflicting mortal wounds which caused the death of SEAN HADDOCK on the 3rd day of August 2023, contrary to the provisions of Section 711 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Brenton Brown, being a duly sworn Detective for the City of Edmond, Oklahoma, Oklahoma County swear the following statements to be true:

On 08/03/2023 at approximately 0928 hours, Edmond Police responded to a shooting at 777 East 15th Street Apartment #122, Edmond, Oklahoma County, OK. The reporting party advised that the Defendant, Jennifer Haddock, had shot her brother, Sean Haddock in the chest. Upon arriving at the scene, Officers observed the Defendant inside the apartment with her brother, lying on the floor in the hallway. The Defendant told Officers that she had shot her brother with a .40 caliber. Sean Haddock was pronounced deceased at the scene. He was found to have a single gunshot wound to the chest.

The investigation revealed that the apartment was the home of the Defendant's mother. The Defendant's brother, Sean Haddock, also stayed at the apartment and had property there. The Defendant's mother was a witness to this incident. She advised that Sean Haddock had been yelling at the Defendant and was extremely upset regarding a civil matter related to the ownership of furniture inside the residence. She advised that the argument escalated, and Sean Haddock approached the Defendant in an aggressive manner. The argument became heated. She advised that she heard a single gunshot.

The Defendant was interviewed under Miranda. She stated that her brother was screaming and aggressively approached her to where she was backed against a wall. The Defendant was carrying a 40 Caliber handgun. The Defendant stated that she drew her firearm, telling Sean Haddock to "back up" several times. At one point, she stated Sean Haddock grabbed her firearm, telling her to shoot him. There was separation and upon him advancing back toward the Defendant, she fired a single round which struck Sean Haddock in the chest area.

Based upon the above facts and circumstances, this investigation supports that sufficient probable cause exists for the filing of criminal charges: **First Degree Manslaughter 21-711**
