PROPOSITIONS

PROPOSITION 1.

SHALL ORDINANCE NO. 2574 OF THE CITY OF EDMOND, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, BE APPROVED TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF EDMOND TO EXTEND THE THREE-FOURTHS OF ONE PERCENT (¾ OF 1%) SALES TAX APPROVED BY THE VOTERS IN 1996 AS SET OUT IN ORDINANCE NO. 2293, SAID FUNDS TO BE EXPENDED TO FUND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AS RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL BY THE CAPITAL FINANCING TASK FORCE?

PROPOSITION 2.

SHALL ORDINANCE NO. 2575 OF THE CITY OF EDMOND, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, BE APPROVED TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF EDMOND TO LEVY AND ASSESS A CITY EXCISE (SALES) TAX OF THREE-EIGHTHS OF ONE PERCENT (¾ OF 1%), SAID FUNDS TO BE USED FOR PUBLIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL FIRE-FIGHTERS AND POLICE PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT FOR SAID PERSONNEL, ADDITIONAL FIREFIGHTING AND RESCUE EQUIPMENT, ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES, AND COMPETITIVE COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS FOR EXISTING AND RETIRED FIRE PERSONNEL AND POLICE OFFICERS; ESTABLISHING A LIMITED TAX FUND AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND ADMINISTRATION OF SAID TAX FUNDS AS SPECIFIED IN ORDINANCE NO. 2575?
