Thank you for your inquiry.

Once someone becomes a resident of the State and is no longer just visiting, he must obtain an Oklahoma license. Although Oklahoma does recognize licenses from foreign countries of visitors, his status as a resident (whether legally residing or illegally residing) invalidates his Mexico license.

I hope this helps.

If you would like, I can do a little research and find the statute.
